




Dimensions

- The board is 3.6x3.6 meters (11.8x11.8 ft)
- It has a 100 cm kickboard (3.2 ft)

The Structure


The board can be installed as a self-standing structure or wall-mounted.

- **Self-Standing:** Stands 4.5 meters (14.7 ft) tall at 15° and requires 1 meter (3.2 ft) of clearance behind it.
- Wall-Mounted: Requires just 40 cm (1.31 ft) of clearance.
- **Display to change the angles**: the board comes with a touchscreen display to change the angles from 15° to 70°.



HRT 500

The HRT 500 for the Quantum Board M 12x12 includes 386 climbing holds - from jugs, slopers, pinches, pockets to uncut edge crimps and technical footholds. The holds are made from high quality polyurethane and **SKUISH** material.



SKUISH

SKUISH is a game-changing material developed by Composite X to transform climbing holds. These polyurethane holds are coated with a special rubber layer, making them super comfortable and gentle on your skin.

Skin-Friendly Climbing Holds

Climbing holds that do not hurt the skin and allow you to train longer and harder.

More Durable Material

Unlike traditional hold textures that wear down and become polished over time, the rubber layer on **SKUISH** holds stops this from happening, ensuring a consistent and reliable grip even after heavy use

Easy to Clean

The **SKUISH** climbing holds are easier to maintain than regular polyurethane holds.




eWalls App

eWalls App

Multiplayer Mode

The eWalls App is the first climbing app to enable multiple routes to be illuminated simultaneously, allowing climbers to train and climb together in real time.




When you start climbing, select a problem and click "Play".

If a second climber wants to climb and display a problem on the board, they can. The app will ask them to choose a color and display their route in that color. They can browse through the routes while the first climber is still climbing.

This won't turn off the holds of the first climber's route.

The app can support 4 climbers at the same time.

If a hold is already lit up by the first climber and the second climber wants to use it, the app will signal that the route cannot be displayed due to a conflict.




Easy and Precise Setting

Each hold in the set has a specific location and direction on the board. The line that shows the direction of the hold has to be matched with the arrow that shows the direction.

The Indicators on the Board

On the board, you'll find the number of the hold, a line that always points south, and another line indicating the hold's direction.



The "500" Holds

Each hold in the set comes with specific indicators that show the direction of the hold on the board, as well as the number of the hold.
